

What Is Cutera Dermal Laser Treatment?

Cutera® laser treatment is a minimally invasive procedure that uses advanced laser technology to treat varicose veins and spider veins. It involves delivering pulses of light energy that coagulate the blood within the veins, destroying them and allowing the body to reabsorb the veins. Blood flow is then redirected to deeper veins below the skin's surface, causing the visible veins to disappear.





WHAT CAN CUTERA TREAT?

Harbour Vascular offers advanced treatments for varicose, reticular, and spider veins. Both **SCLEROTHERAPY** and **CUTERA** effectively reduce vein visibility, each suited to different conditions and aftercare needs, ensuring a tailored approach to treatment.

SCLEROTHERAPY	CUTERA DERMAL LASER
Chemical solution injected into the vein, causing it to collapse and fade over time.	Laser energy is applied to the vein, causing blood to coagulate and vein to collapse . The body will then remove the coagulated blood.
Suitable for smaller varicose and reticular veins.	Suitable for reticular veins and spider veins.
Some downtime may be required, with restrictions on activities for a short period post-treatment.	Minimal downtime, patients can resume normal activities almost immediately.
Compression stockings will need to be worn post treatment to reduce the risk of clots developing.	Generally, no stockings are required post-treatment.
Multiple sessions may be needed for optimal results.	Up to 3 treatments in recommended for optimal results.
After effects include redness, swelling, and mild discomfort in the treated area. Skin discolouration/pigmentation from coagulated blood may take up to 6 months to fade.	Side effects include bruising, swelling, and temporary discomfort at the site of laser therapy.
